What Are Wisdom Teeth?

Wisdom teeth are the third set of molars, usually coming through between the ages of 17 and 25. For many people, these teeth don't have enough space to grow properly, often leading to discomfort, crowding, or infections.

If your dentist has recommended that you have your wisdom teeth removed, choosing an experienced oral surgeon is essential for ensuring a safe, smooth procedure and a fast recovery.

Why Might Wisdom Teeth Need To Be Removed?

Not everyone needs their wisdom teeth taken out. However, removal is commonly advised if:

- They are impacted – stuck under the gum or growing at an angle
- There isn't enough space in the mouth, which may cause crowding or misalignment
- They cause pain or swelling
- Recurrent infections such as pericoronitis occur
- Cysts or other complications develop around the teeth

Early assessment and, if necessary, timely removal can prevent more serious issues in the future.

Consultation and Imaging
